Here are the employment statistics of our recent graduates as they have entered the professional field of interior design or continued their education into a graduate program. The average salary they are earning within the first 2 years of employment is also included.

This data was collected from our students that graduated between 7/1/2016 to 6/30/2017. The figures are calculated utilizing the ACICS Placement formula and reported to ACICS (Accrediting Council for Independent Schools and Colleges) and CIDA (Council for Interior Design Accreditation). The Placement Rate is defined by ACICS in terms of the total number of graduates minus those who are not placed (employed), divided by the total number of graduates, and expressed as a percent. The placement rate is calculated based upon data submitted for the annual Campus Accountability Report (CAR) and according to the detailed formula and terms defined in the Guidelines and Instructions for the Campus Accountability Report ±

Placement Rate = Number of Placed Graduates DIVIDED BY Number of Eligible Graduates

Eligible Graduates = Total Number of Graduates MINUS Number of Visa-restricted Graduates MINUS Number of Exempt Graduates

Visa-restricted Graduates = Graduates who are not available for placement due to visa restrictions

Exempt Graduates = Graduates who are not available for placement due to active military service, enrollment in continuing education or ESL program, incarceration, death, or pregnancy or other health issues
